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### **Purpose**

The Microcomputer Operations Certificate was developed for those who wish to master computer and networking skills required for IT industry certifications.

## **Admission Requirements**

Students who meet the admission requirements to the College are eligible for enrollment into the program. Individuals are expected to be proficient in basic English, mathematics and reading. Appropriate developmental courses are available for those who need to update their skills.

## **Program Description**

Courses related to networking are taught using lecture and hands-on laboratory experiences using industrial equipment. Optional test preparation materials and practice examinations are available and students are strongly encouraged to take advantage of this service. Two courses are general education topics and the remaining twelve courses are program related.

# **Employment Outlook**

With the ever-increasing uses of technology, trained technicians will be in demand. Job outlook for all occupations is about 12 percent, but the employment for those in computer support is expected to be 17 percent through 2022\*. It is predicted that organizations will continue to upgrade computer equipment and software.
